

CAMPUS PARKING IMPROVEMENT AND GREEN AREAS DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM (2021-2025)

Annotation: The Campus Parking Improvement and Green Areas Development Program (2021-2025) at the International University of Tourism and Entrepreneurship of Tajikistan focuses on reducing the share of paved parking areas and expanding green and pedestrian zones to create a more sustainable and comfortable campus environment. As a result of the program, parking spaces were reduced by 33%, while green areas increased by 22%, with new pedestrian alleys and recreation spaces added. Priority was given to low- and zero-emission mobility options such as bicycles and electric scooters.

The program improves the microclimate and ecological balance of the campus, reducing asphalt heat accumulation and lowering average summer temperatures by 1.2°C. It also enhances safety and comfort for students and staff and contributes to a 15% reduction in transport-related CO₂ emissions.

The initiative directly supports SDG 11 (Sustainable Cities and Communities), SDG 13 (Climate Action), and SDG 15 (Life on Land) by creating a more resilient, green, and student-centered campus landscape
